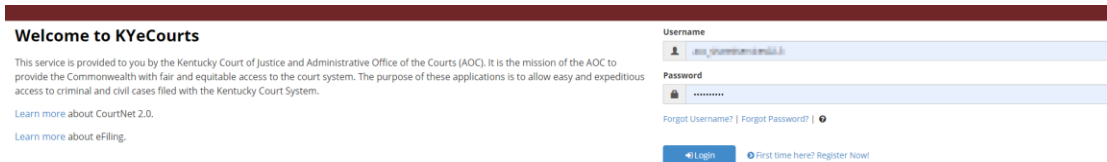

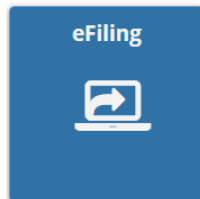
Petition to Challenge Constitutionality

eFilers may now file a Petition to Challenge Constitutionality per [HB3](#) enacted during the [2021 Regular Legislative Session](#). To file a Petition to Challenge Constitutionality:

1. Login to KYeCourts



2. Select eFiling



3. Click the eFile menu in the top tool bar and select *New Case*.
4. Select the appropriate jurisdiction from the *'Select a Jurisdiction'* dropdown menu.
5. Select Circuit Civil Action from the *'What would you like to file?'* dropdown menu.
6. Select Circuit Civil: Petition to Challenge Constitutionality from the *'Select the most appropriate option.'* Drop-down menu.

Long Arm Statute – SOS – Restricted Delivery postage has been updated in eFiling per the United States Postal Service increase in postage effective August 29th, 2021. The Long Arm – SOS – Restricted Delivery amount is now \$16.00 (the statutory fee plus the restricted delivery fee.)
